## HIKING &

### Cahuilla Mountain Trail (one-day hike)

A 5.7-mile-and-out back popular trail near Anza, the Cahuilla Mountain Trail is considered a moderately challenging route and takes an average of three hours to complete. Antique Cahuilla village sites line the trail. Meanwhile, explorers will delight in signing their name inside an old army can at the top to celebrate their climbing accomplishment.

#### **Pacific Crest Trail**
