### The Hemet Museum

The Hemet Museum offers an eclectic collection of early American, railway and Native American artifacts, each focused on preserving the history of the San Jacinto Valley. Located inside the Hemet Santa Fe Depot, the museum is nestled in a 19th century freight house. Continued changes over the years have improved access as well as the presentation of diverse relics and artifacts with particular attention given to the local area Native Americans.

### Idyllwild Area Historical Society

The Idyllwild Area Historical Society is dedicated to preserving and sharing the history of the San Jacinto Mountains. Other exhibits include rustic 1930 cabin houses that highlight the surrounding communities of Idyllwild, Pine Cove, Mountain Center, Alandale, Garner Valley, and Pinewood.
